HEAT TREATMENT CHECKLIST

Our goal at ABC Pest Control is to provide you with the most effective heat treatment against bed bug infestations. In order to do so, we need your co-operation in preparing your home to ensure the best results possible.

In order to effectively prepare your suite for treatment, make sure you go through the following step by step procedure and check off the actions required.

Hang clothes up in closets. Stored clothes in drawers must not be higher than 3 inches in depth. Take clothes deeper than 3 inches out of drawers and leave them in piles no higher 3 inches in depth on top of the dresser. This will allow proper airflow and heat penetration. Densely stored clothes in closets can be thinned out and moved to the bathroom and hung on the shower rod, and/ or stored in open weave laundry baskets.

Hang bedding overtop of interior doors or closet doors. If you have too much additional bedding, blankets and clothing it must be removed and dried on HIGH HEAT for a minimum of 1hour, then placed in a garbage bag and returned to the suite, and labelled as "Treated."

NOTICE: all garbage bags must be SEALED TIGHTLY in order to prevent bugs from re-infesting

Any paper or lighter items may be blown around by strong air movement from the fans, ensure that they are boxed or stored to prevent them being blown around and destroyed

Area rugs must be loosely rolled up and stood on end and left in an area to be treated

 \Box Air beds and beds with electric pumps must be partially deflated and unplugged from the wall.

Batteries must be removed from battery powered items such as TV remotes.

Purses, backpacks, walkers and wheelers must be left behind for the treatment. Take only your wallet, cash and any medication you may need for the entire day.

Ensure the clothes you are going to wear out of your home on the day of the treatment are bug free by placing them in the dryer on high heat for at least 45 minutes. Keep them in a sealed bag and put them on just prior to leaving your home the day of the treatment.

Leave a complete change of clothes for each family member in the entryway of your home in a bag clearly marked "CHANGE OF CLOTHES". This change of clothes will help ensure that you have clothing that are to be worn as soon as you come in the door, which has been heat treated along with the other items in the home.

If a change of clothes is not left for each family member, ABC Pest Control may refuse to treat your home/suite and you will be responsible for a \$250 cancellation fee. If you wish to cancel or postpone your treatment for any reason, we require 72 hours notice or you will be charged a \$250 cancellation fee.

STEP 5 - POST-TREATMENT: WHEN YOU RETURN

Immediately change into your now treated clothing (change of clothes) that you had left by the front door. DO NOT walk through your home wearing the untreated clothes you wore out while the home was being treated.

You should carefully bag the clothes you walked in wearing, and then immediately put the clothes in the dryer on high heat for at least 45 minutes to avoid re-infestation.

Thoroughly clean and dust the entire home. Vacuum all mattresses, chairs, sofas, and floorboards thoroughly on the highest suction setting. This will help rid the home of the dead bedbug carcasses and eggs as well. Throw away the vacuum bag immediately by placing it into a sealed plastic bag and then into the outdoor garbage bin (out of the home).

Please ensure your family and friends do not re-infest your home with bedbugs by them bringing them in on themselves and their clothing. Encourage them to ensure they and their homes are rid of the bugs before they come for a visit.

NOTICE: Your home will likely be much warmer than usual when you arrive. This is normal as your home was heated to a very high temperature while you were out, and it will take some time to cool down. Open windows or turn on your air conditioner (in summer only as to not damage the air conditioner) to help cool it down.

Tenant realizes that the heat treatment brings the dwelling and items to a very high heat (65 to 72 degrees celcius) which creates the risk of warping or damaging items such as PVC finished furniture and cabinets and windows, veneered furniture, silicone and grout on tiles, glued items etc., and ABC Pest Control Ltd. is not responsible for any damage that may occur.
